Notice of meeting: Eden Park Redevelopment Project

As you may be aware from recent media articles, the Eden Park Trust Board and the Government have established a new Redevelopment Board for managing the plans to develop Eden Park for the finals of Rugby World Cup 2011. This agreement includes new design plans for the Park (details of which can be found on Eden Park's website at <http://www.edenpark.co.nz/redevelopment>).

The Redevelopment Board plans to hold two public meetings to update local residents on the redevelopment and, in particular, the plans for assessing the effects of shading from the new South Stand.

The meetings will be at Eden Park at **7.30pm** on:

- **Thursday 28 June (West Lounge, West Stand via Entrance F, Gate 26, Reimers Avenue)**
- **Wednesday 04 July (Hall of Legends, ASB Stand, Walters Road)**
