

Eden Park parking project update for Residents association website

Dear residents

During this year a lot of progress has been made with the Eden Park parking scheme project. Thanks to residents input we will implement a number of changes over the next 18 months. These changes are intended to better accommodate the needs of your community and reflect your suggestions.

We are pleased to inform you that the project is running six months ahead of schedule and that in time for the new year residents living in the current permit scheme area will enjoy

- more flexibility around permit provisions
- easy to administer temporary permits for visitors
- temporary permits available from Eden Park in the new year
- comprehensive online parking scheme information
- application forms on line

Over the next two years we will work with other transport partners to deliver holistic solutions that address the traffic management needs of your community on event days. This includes a proposed extension of the existing scheme area in mid 2009. At this time, changes to signage rules (traffic control device rules) will enable the use of street signage that is informative, less cluttered and therefore in line with the council's urban design strategy. We will continue to update you on initiatives as we near implementation.

Auckland City Council wishes to thank all residents who took the time to provide feedback about the scheme over the past year. With your input we will continue to make improvements to your parking scheme.
