Subject: Review of existing residents parking scheme around Eden Park

Recently I contacted you to let you know that Auckland City Council and Eden Park Trust Board are reviewing the existing residents parking scheme for the area surrounding Eden Park.

The first stage of the review includes research and consultation with stakeholders, including yourselves. As part of this process, we will be holding two open forum feedback sessions with all stakeholders invited to attend these sessions.

The purpose of these feedback sessions is to enable the council to gain an in-depth understanding of stakeholders perceived requirements in relation to parking during events at Eden Park.. It will also be an opportunity for residents who are not currently in the scheme to indicate if they believe that the parking impacts extend to their street at the time of Eden Park events.

These feedback sessions will be held at 6.30pm on Monday, 30 July 2007 and Thursday, 2 August 2007 in the Eden Room at Eden Park, entry at Entrance E (parking is provided onsite)

For those unable to attend a feedback session, an online feedback survey form can be completed at www.aucklandcity.govt.nz/parking. If you do not have access to the internet we are happy to send out a hard copy of the survey in the mail by calling the council on 379 2020. The closing date for feedback will be Friday 3 August 2007.

The timeframes we will be working towards are outlined in the project timetable below.

Presentation of potential solutions to stakeholder groups	Mid September 2007
Feedback sought on potential solutions	Late September 2007
Preferred solution (with incorporated changes) presented to stakeholder groups	Late October 2007
Preferred solution presented to the council's transport committee	Feb 2008
Implement any changes to the scheme in time for the 2008 Bledisloe Cup	May / June 2008
